Step 1: Creating an IT strategic plan must first start from the top down, focused on **Corporate Priorities**. Reviewing the Company Vision, Mission and Objectives is essential to understand the business philosophy of the organization. For example if a company has a large Distribution focus, and the key operating metrics are on-time deliveries or same day service, implementing an automated warehouse may become a corporate objective.

If an organization is striving for customer intimacy, a customer relationship management process and tools may be strategic. In many of these initiatives IT investments are catalysts for organizational change.

Other projects may be aligned to the companies cash flow or financial obligations to stakeholders, and strong Business Intelligence tools and methods can provide the means to achieve this.

Some leading edge organizations rely on strong knowledge management functions to continually seek out external information to assist with changing business needs.

Step 2: The next step will focus on your **Business-Driven priorities**. Each department will have individual goals to meet the overall company objectives. Each department will also have metrics with which they will be measured and BI tools will be imperative to make better decisions.

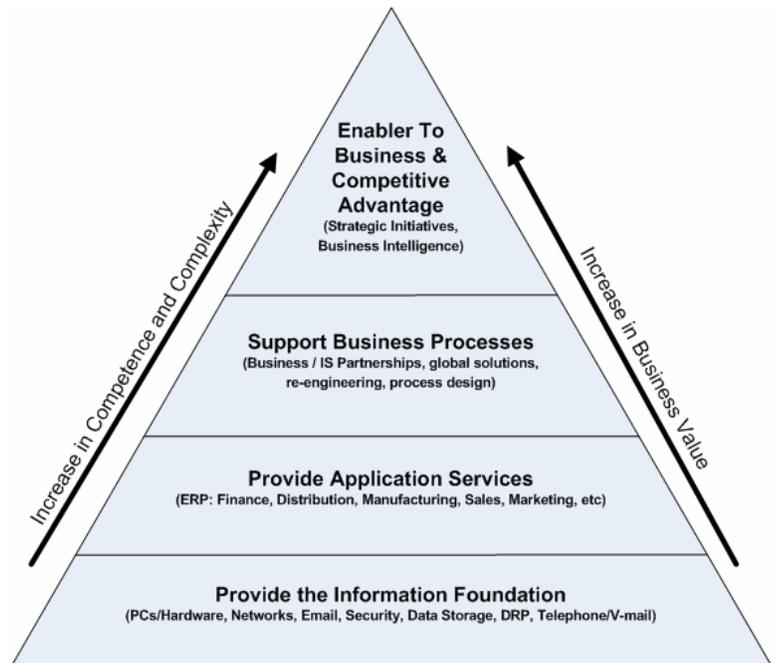
